
Changing the Code in the Gate Remote

On the gate remote, the entire lower half of the front of the case is removable.


1. Using a small screwdriver, pry the cover off (pull it upward and away from the gate remote) to reveal the battery compartment and the code switches.

- 2. The old code has switches 2, 4, 6, 8, and 10 in the "up" position.
- To set the new code, use a pen to change the position of switches 1, 6, 9, and 10.
- 4. **Double check** the remote to verify that the new code is set correctly. Switches 1 and 2 should be up, 3 down, 4 up, 5, 6 and 7 down, 8 and 9 up, and 10 down.
- 5. NOTE: The gate remote uses a 9 volt battery. If the battery in your gate remote has not been replaced recently, this would be a good time to put in a fresh battery.
- 6. Replace the cover on the gate remote.
- 7. Make a note of the manual code that is published in the newsletter so that you can use the keypad if your remote fails to open the gate.
